

## **Information Regarding the Sports Premium Spending 2015-16**

### **What is the Sports Premium?**

This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children.

The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools. In 2015 Grayshott School was given a Sports premium of £8,400

### **Purpose of funding**

Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

### **Possible uses for the funding include:**

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE
- paying for professional development opportunities in PE/sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE/sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sport clubs and holiday clubs.

### **How will we be spending the Sports Funding and who will benefit?**

The Governors agree that the money must be used so that: all children benefit regardless of sporting ability; that the most able children are given the opportunity to compete in advanced tournaments; that staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development.

### **Hiring qualified sports coaches to work alongside teachers to deliver PE**

The school has hired the services of CM Sports, a coaching company who already deliver some of our before and after school clubs, to deliver some games lessons including: invasion games, gymnastic, striking and fielding games and orienteering.

CM Sports also offer extra-curricular opportunities to pupils of both key-stages through clubs after school and during INSET closures. This is impacting to increase our pupil participation in sport.

### **Partnership Work**

The school also uses the money to buy into the Sports partnership at Bohunt Secondary School which means that our children regularly take part in range of competitions including cross country running and basketball.
